

UC Berkeley Capital Projects Invites Students, Neighbors and Community Members to a
Community Discussion about the Anna Head Student Housing Project

Monday, May 11, 2009, 7:00-9:00 pm
All Purpose Room in the Unit 1 Residence Hall

Enter on Channing Way between College and Bowditch. The meeting room is one level below the courtyard. A map is attached, and signs will direct you to the room. ADA access is via Slottman Hall's main entry and elevator.

As many of you know, development of the Anna Head parking lot site (between Channing and Haste, just east of Telegraph) for student housing has been under consideration for a long time. The City of Berkeley's Southside Plan identifies the site for student housing; and this use is consistent with the University's 2020 Long Range Development Plan. The campus completed an Historic Structures Report, conducted a financial analysis and evaluation, and, since our December 2008 community meeting, completed a conceptual master plan for the whole site. (The potential project does not include renovation of the Anna Head buildings.)

Staff will present the conceptual master plan and massing schemes and describe how the plan responds to community concerns.

This is an opportunity for you to provide early input about the project. We want to hear your ideas to help inform the definition and development of the project. As planning and design proceed, there will be additional opportunities for formal comment and review by City staff, commissions, and the public.

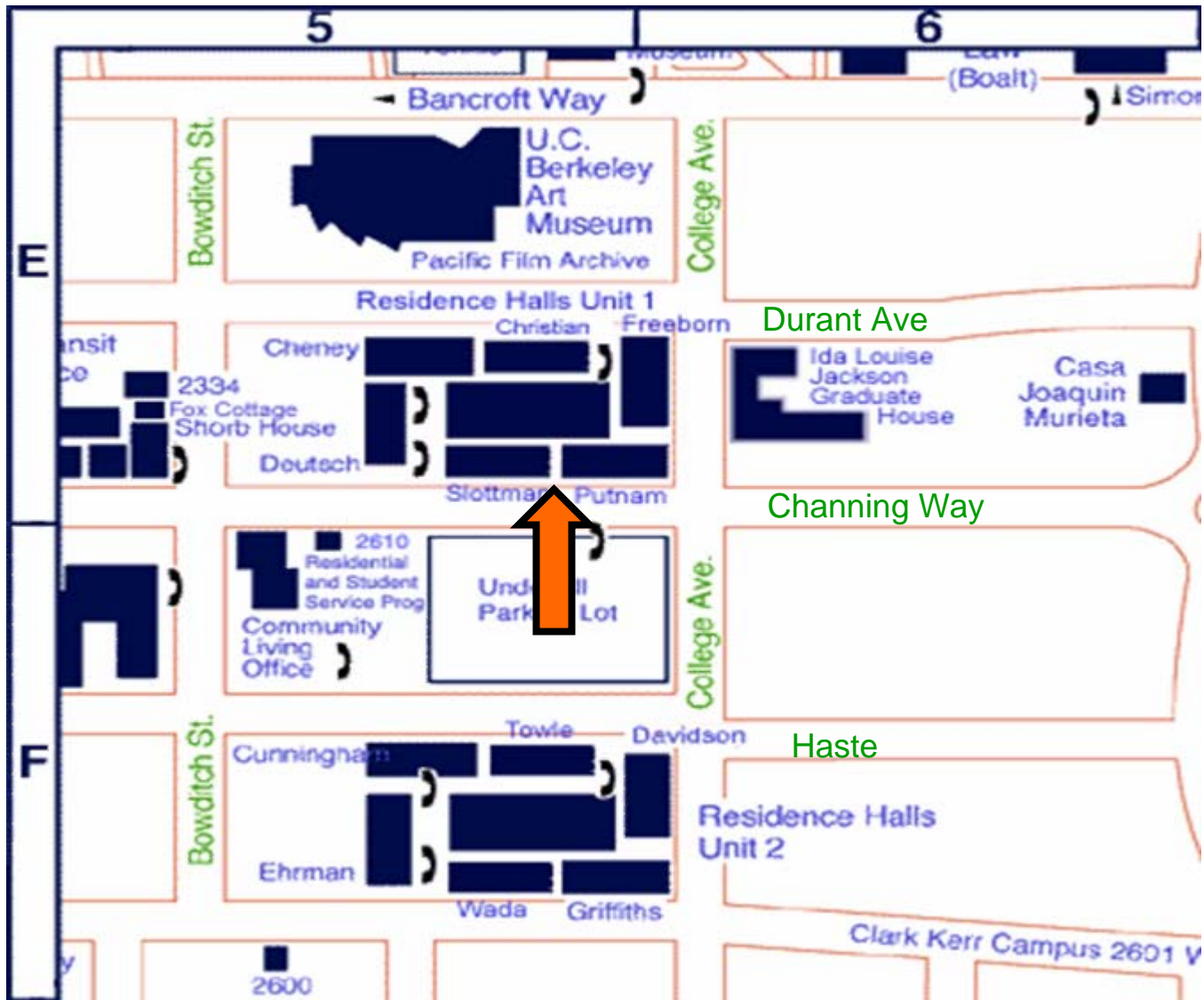
